

The student Innovation LABS (SIL): Workshop on Managerial and entrepreneurial skills (3 credits are awarded for attending one SIL Training Workshop).

Since the start of the academic Year 2020-2021, University of Milan, supported by the network of mentors and companies of the Unimi Foundation, has launched “The Student Innovation Labs” (SIL) program. This program offers students a multidisciplinary learning context, the opportunity to develop an entrepreneurial culture, acquire soft skills and carry out innovation projects through cooperation with companies and professionals. SIL consists of the following three (not necessarily) sequential phases (skillsets): Training, Empowerment and Acceleration. For more information on this initiative please visit the below website:

Please note that, for year 2021, three SIL Training Workshops will take place, one of which will be held in English. Each one of the workshops will last about 30 hours and can have approximately 30 participants. Three credits (CFU-s) are earned for attending one SIL Training Workshop. Awarded credits are applicable to the “Internship and other activities” part of the MHR/MLS program.

The first SIL Training Workshop, starting in March 2021 and lasting about 30 hours (over a period of approximately 6/8 weeks), will focus on the world of startups and social innovation. This workshop is primarily intended for final year bachelor students, master degree students and doctoral ones.
