Exams sessions available

Second trimester courses (January-March)

- 1st exam session November 2021*
- 2nd exam session December 2021* (from 9/12/2021 to 21/12/2021)
- 3rd exam session March-April 2022 (from 22/03/2021 to 2/04/2021)
- 4th exam session May-June 2022
- 5th exam session July 2022 (starting from 4/7/2022)
- 6th exam session September 2022 (from 1/9/2022 to 17/9/2022)

Third trimester courses (April-June)

- 1st exam session November 2021*
- 2nd exam session January 2022*
- 3rd exam session March-April 2022* (from 22/03/2021 to 2/04/2021)
- 4th exam session June 2022 (from 27/6/2022 to 2/7/2022)
- 5th exam session July 2022 (starting from 4/7/2022)
- 6th exam session September 2022 (from 1/9/2022 to 17/9/2022)

* Only for students who attended the courses in 2020/2021 or previous years

How to register for exams?

To register for exams or verify correct registration, students can:

- access the online exams registration service
- access the "Exams and course evaluation" section through UNIMIA

When registering for an exam, students may be asked to fill in the Course Evaluation Questionnaire.

To take the exam, **students must have registered** in the indicated period. Registration normally close **5-4 days before the exam date!**

In person exams

Written and oral exams **will take place in person**, in compliance with safety and distancing rules. Waivers to the in-person exam requirement will be granted **only for the following reasons**:

- Covid-19 positive tested or quarantined students
- Students with underlying **certified** health concerns, as laid down by law
- Students residing in countries with health restrictions or cross-border travel restrictions, unable to travel to Italy.

To take the exam and access the University is mandatory to have a valid **Green Pass**

Requirements to take the exams

Students who wish to sit exams must:

- be up to date with payment of university fees and dues
- have passed any preparation courses, if present
- have registered through the online exams' registration service on time
- have an attendance certificate, where required

Please note:

Exam sessions from 1 October to 28 February pertain to the previous academic year and the student does not have to re-enrol in the current academic year.

How to check the results?

To check exam results, even those of partial exams, students can:

- access the online publication of results service
- access the section "Reporting of exam results" through UNIMIA

Important rules – Check frequently for the results!

- Once the results are available, students are required **within one week** to accept the grade (which will be registered in their career) or refuse the grade and decide to re-sit for the exam in the next available sessions.
- Students who are not satisfied with the grade and wish to retake the exam **must refuse the grade within one week** from its publication, otherwise they will find the grade automatically in their career
- Students cannot repeat an exam they have already passed or a training activity from previous studies that has been recognized.

Q&A

Italian grading system

- Min grade to pass the exam is 18
- Max grade is 30 cum laude (= 33)
- Average between the grades

How to decide?

GPA (media)

>25 for graduation → 85/95

>27 → 100/110 cum laude

Graduation grades – 66 (min) to 110 cum laude (max)

What company are asking is the graduation grade! - GPA
